

SCIENCE

We will develop an understanding of animals including humans, which includes the digestive system and food chains.

We will also develop an understanding of how sounds are made and how they are heard.

ENGLISH

We will apply topic knowledge to write in different forms and for audiences including recounts and stories with historical settings.

MATHEMATICS

We will use and apply the skills and concepts to a selection of topic related problems.

ICT

Using the Vikings as inspiration, we will create and manipulate pictures using control and monitoring software.

MUSIC

We will learn to play the samba drums as part of Hampshire's Listen-2-Me programme.



HISTORY

We will develop a deeper understanding of who the Vikings were and why they came to Britain. We will also look at the lasting impact of their time in Britain.

During our visit to Upton Court we will look at the impact of the Vikings on life in Celtic Britain.

PE

We will develop our awareness of tactics to enhance skills during invasion games including tag rugby. We will create and perform dances to rock and roll music. We will develop map reading skills and orienteering around the school.

GEOGRAPHY

We will look at where and why the Vikings invaded and then focus on their settlements.
