History

We will be exploring the Ancient Greeks, looking at Greek architecture, beliefs and exploring the significance of the Greek Legacy.

Geography

We will be learning about earthquakes towards the end of the first term; why and where they happen.

Science

During the term we concentrate on living things and their habitats, including animal classification. We extend the children's knowledge and skills in light, and how we see things.

ICT

In the first half of the term, the children will be developing their understanding of 'control' using the Scratch programme in school. In the second half of term, children will develop their spreadsheet skills and apply these to real-life situations.

P.E

In Gymnastics we shall be creating complex sequences, demonstrating a high degree of control in synchronization and cannon. In Games we will be covering skills and teamwork in hockey. In dance we will create group compositions, based on an Ancient Greek theme.

PSHE

This term, the emphasis is on Rights, Respect and Responsibility and how the children can become more effective in developing their understanding of these principles.

R.E

Based on Hampshire's curriculum for schools, 'Living Difference', we will be exploring creation stories from the world's main religions and the different biblical interpretations of the birth of Jesus.

Art

During the first half of the term we will be studying 'people in action', basing our designs around Greek artwork and pottery from the Olympics.

Design Technology

The children will spend time designing and making a pair of slippers. They will learn how a range of products are developed for different purposes and people.

French

The children are entering their fourth year of French as a Modern Foreign Language. The emphasis will be on oral French and so the children will be learning through conversation, games and songs.
