

SCIENCE

We will be focusing on Light and Dark where we will explore shadows and how we can reflect light. (Linked with English story 'The Dark')

We will apply our knowledge to create our own shadow puppet shows and writing playscripts to go with them (linked with English)

COMPUTING

This term we will be using Google to research Hartley Wintney while also thinking about keeping safe on the internet.

ART

Our main focus in art this term is to practise our colour mixing skills with primary and secondary colours as well as creating shades to show shadows (linking to our work on The Dark). We will apply these skills to create a piece of artwork to go with our Dark stories.

P.S.H.E

We will be following the 'Friends' programme and working on strategies for building our confidence and resilience. We will also teach children strategies for dealing with friendship issues.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

We will be evaluating and creating a range of healthy salads. We will also have the Warburtons sandwich team visiting us and helping us design and make a healthy sandwich.

GEOGRAPHY

This term we will be undertaking a geographical study of Hartley Wintney in which we will be exploring settlement types, investigating land use in the village, looking at the services provided in the village and producing our own Tourist Guide for visitors to Hartley Wintney (linked with English)

MUSIC

The children will be working on using un-tuned percussion instruments to compose and play their own compositions as a group. Children will be trying to keep in time with one another and maintain their rhythm.

P.E

In gymnastics we will be working individually, in pairs and in small groups; learning to control our bodies to jump and move in time to some music. We will also be investigating ways of balancing on different body parts. In games we will be working at passing and catching a large ball in netball.

As part of Hampshire's curriculum for schools we will be exploring the life and teachings of Jesus and investigating what Christians believe about Easter. We will also be focusing on the role churches play in religions.
