

SCIENCE

In science we will be finding out about magnets and springs. In the second half of the term we will be looking at plants and what they need to grow.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be making comparisons between the city of Rome in Italy and the city of London in the UK, with a focus on how settlements change and develop through time. We will also be learning about how volcanoes develop and why they erupt, linking in to our History topic of the Romans and Pompeii.

PSHE

COMPUTING


In the first half of this term we will be using PowerPoint to write a set of instructions. Following this we will be introducing databases, inputting information and using our databases to answer questions.
