

## **SCIENCE**

We will focus on the water cycle as a hook into our main theme of water. Later on in the term we will learn about the human body and animal life cycles.

## **GEOGRAPHY**

We will learn about rivers and water this term. We will take part in a river study on our trip to the river Selbourne. Our writing, spellings and other areas of the curriculum will also link to the theme of water and rivers.

## **PSHE**

We will discuss changes and the human body later on in the term; this will link to our SRE teaching after half term.

## **PE**
